

Limerick, The Cliffs of Moher, Bunratty Castle, The Burren & Galway Bay

Start your adventure bright and early at **Dublin Heuston Station** for a 07:00hrs departure on a comfortable InterCity train to **Limerick** (snacks available on board). Sit back and watch the Irish countryside come to life as you glide through the heart of Ireland towards one of its most breathtaking regions.

We join our coach in Limerick, a city steeped in history on the banks of the mighty **River Shannon**, to visit **Bunratty Castle & Folk Park Village** en route to our lunch stop at a traditional Irish Pub (not included). Then, we visit the spectacular **Cliffs of Moher**, some of the highest sea cliffs in Europe. Enjoy a short hike along the cliff path rising 215 metres above the pounding **Atlantic Ocean**. We continue our journey along the **Wild Atlantic Way** through the lunar landscape of the **Burren** region, a UNESCO Geo-Park famous for its fauna and flora.

We then head along the shores of **Galway Bay** for a flavour of **Galway City** in time for dinner (not included & traffic permitting). We join the InterCity train at **Galway Ceannt Station**, for our journey back to Dublin, departing at 19.20hrs. Arriving at Dublin Heuston Station 21.55hrs (9.55pm).



One-Day Tour: DH02 Cork, Blarney Castle, Cobh & the Titanic Story



The Ring of Kerry

Check in at Dublin Heuston Station for the 07.00hrs InterCity train to **Killarney** (snacks available on board). Sit back and enjoy the relaxing journey through the heart of Ireland to Killarney, gateway to the world-famous **Ring of Kerry**.

Travel by luxury coach around this breathtaking 179km route, where every bend reveals some of the most spectacular scenery in Ireland, set between the mountains of **Kerry** ('**The MacGillycuddy Reeks**') and the **Wild Atlantic coastline**. We return to Killarney for our train back to Dublin. Arriving at Dublin Heuston at 21.00hrs (9.00pm).



Aran Islands & Scenic Flight over Galway Bay

Check in at **Dublin Heuston Station** for the 07.35hrs departure on a comfortable InterCity train to **Galway**. Embark on an unforgettable adventure to the wild and beautiful west of Ireland.

From Galway, enjoy a short transfer to **Connemara Airport** and board a scenic flight over **Galway Bay** to **Inis Mór**. The largest of the three **Aran Islands**, Inis Mór is a bastion of traditional Irish language, culture and music, and is unique in its geology, archaeology and history.

Experience a guided tour of Inis Mór, including a visit to the awe-inspiring **Dún Aonghasa**, a prehistoric stone fortress dramatically perched on a 100-metre cliff overlooking the Atlantic Ocean – one of the most magnificent Celtic monuments in Western Europe. After exploring the island, you will return to the village of **Kilronan**, where you can browse the famous **Aran Sweater Market** or relax over lunch (not included).

We then return to Galway, where you will have time to explore the city centre and have dinner (traffic permitting & not included).

Waterford Crystal & Kilkenny City

Titanic Rail Trail & Wild Atlantic Way including Donegal

Travel South, South West, West, East, North and North West. An eleven-day tour that encompasses almost everything that we do (and we can add on Waterford as an extra day tour if you wish). We include the highlights of Ireland with the theme of the ill-fated **Titanic** story. We visit **Cork**, **Blarney Castle & Cobh** (near Cork City), the ship's last port of call. We include **Belfast** where she was built, we explore **Clifden** in **Connemara**, where Jack Phillips, the Titanic's wireless operator, worked for Marconi before the fatal voyage. Moored very close to the **Titanic Visitor Centre** is the very last original White Star Line ship; the **SS Nomadic**, which is now open to the public (admission not included). Your Hop-On/Hop-Off tour ticket will take you to **Grand Central Station** for your train to **Derry** at 15.10hs (3.10pm).
