13:35 Coach departs Cork Station for Blarney Castle and Gardens.

14:00 Arrive at Blarney Castle. You will have ample time to visit Blarney Castle and its wonderful gardens, don't forget to kiss the Blarney Stone and bestow yourself the gift of eternal eloquence!

16:30 Depart Blarney for Fota Island Resort.

o8:30 Your luggage will be portered to our coach (you will see it next at Killarney Park Hotel) and we will depart by coach to Cóbh Train Station. Before you board your train you will have an opportunity to visit Cóbh Heritage Centre – The Queenstown Story, an excellent interactive exhibition, chronicling the history of Irish emigration, famine, Titanic and Lusitania, all with connections to Cóbh (pronounced "Cove").

10:15 Depart Cóbh by train to Killarney via Mallow, County Cork, arriving at Killarney, County Kerry at 13:05. Morning coffee and a light lunch will be served before arrival in Killarney.

13:10 Depart by coach for the world renowned Ring of Kerry scenic drive. This one hundred mile circuit is mostly along the Wild Atlantic Way. You will have plenty of stops en route for photos/coffee etc. Alternatively, you can relax and pamper yourself in Killarney for the day.
